## To whom it may concern

We hereby confirm that Danogips A/S in Denmark, part of Knauf Group, Germany, for more than 3 years - under a long term contract – has been using recycled gypsum powder supplied by Gips Recycling A/S (Gypsum Recycling International A/S) for the manufacture of new virgin gypsum plasterboards.

Gips Recycling has made the recycled gypsum powder from gypsum plasterboard waste from new constructions and old gypsum plasterboard waste from demolition, which Gips Recycling has collected in the market.

We are currently using equivalent to app. 15.000 tons p.a. of the recycled gypsum powder supplied by Gips Recycling and up till now we have had no problems with the usage of this material. For longer periods of time we have used more than 22% of the recycled powder in our raw material mix and we expect that we can increase this percentage even further.

Prior to our cooperation with Gips Recycling, Gips Recycling guaranteed that the delivered gypsum powder would be free from contamination and foreign materials like screws, nails, wallpaper, paper, plastic etc. Gips Recycling has lived up to this obligation and therefore the supplied gypsum powder can be applied directly in our production facility.

Except for storage facilities we have had to make no additional investments to apply the gypsum powder, and the recycled gypsum powder is now an integral part of our raw material supply.

We also confirm that Gips Recycling is a professional supplier, that the supplied materials are in the agreed quality and that we in every aspect are pleased with the cooperation.
